

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



Pressed West Country ham hock terrine, plum and apple chutney
Grilled fillet of Cornish mackerel, cherry tomato compôte, pesto toast, rocket



Carrot and coriander soup
Pear and elderflower sorbet




Roast free-range locally reared Banbury turkey, chestnut and apricot stuffing, pigs in blankets, cranberry sauce, bread sauce and gravy made from its own juices
Honey and citrus glazed gammon, grape chutney and Cumberland sauce
Grilled fillet of locally landed haddock, sauté potatoes, spinach, nut brown butter, capers, prawns
Pan fried fillet of Cornish John Dory, leeks, slow roast tomato, Parma ham, basil butter sauce served with a selection of seasonal vegetables and potatoes

White chocolate blondie and pecan nut, fudge sauce and Cornish vanilla ice cream

NEW YEAR'S EVE DINNER

Locally landed monkfish and tiger prawns, saffron nage, sea vegetables

Ham hock fritter, free range poached egg, piccalilli

Hand picked St Ives bay crab, herb mayonnaise, citrus fruits, yuzu dressing



Cornish fish soup

Pink grapefruit and vodka sorbet



Roast fillet and slow cooked shoulder of Cornish lamb, boulangère potato, Carrot purée, tenderstem broccoli, redcurrant and thyme jus

Seared fillet of West Country rose veal, root vegetable, creamed Savoy cabbage, horseradish mash, Madeira sauce

Grilled supreme of locally landed hake, sauté potatoes, baby leaf spinach, crisp Parma ham, tomato dressing

Pan fried fillet of wild Cornish turbot, leeks, courgette, lobster croquette, chervil butter sauce served with a selection of seasonal vegetables and potatoes

Vanilla almond frangipane mix pithivier, served with custard sauce and Cornish vanilla ice cream

Rum baba with plum compôte, crème diplomat, raspberry sauce

Three way chocolate mousse, tuiles, crème Chantilly

A selection of Hawkridge Farm cheeses served with quince jelly, biscuits and celery

CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR TARIFF 2017

All the charges listed are per person and fully inclusive of afternoon tea, four-course dinner, bed, breakfast, golf, tennis, programmed entertainment and VAT at 20%.

All hotel rooms are en-suite and come with bathrobes and slippers, swimming towels, telephone, hairdryer, remote control TV, tea/coffee making facilities & iPod dockings tation/radio.

All rooms have the same tariff for the Christmas and New Year period except Suite 10, which carries a supplement of £70.00 per night. You can stay in our cottages and holiday homes at the prices given below and enjoy the full festive programme, or stay on a self catering basis only at our usual rates.

The Christmas programme starts with afternoon tea on the day of arrival and includes a two-course buffet lunch on two days – 25th December served in our restaurant and 26th December served in our bar and lounge. TARIFF NOTES

Children

Children having early dinner and sharing parents' room pay 30% of full rate.

Children age 6 to 14 having dinner and sharing parents' room pay 50% of full rate.

Limited number of family suites available on request. Breakfast and dinner is provided for families with children under 6 in the Country Club Room. Children aged 6 and over can join parents in main restaurant except New Year's Eve where an early dinner is provided for children under 11.

Dog Charges

Dogs are accepted by prior agreement at a cost, excluding any meals, of £10.00 per dog per night. Please note dogs are not permitted in any of the public rooms. We have a designated woodland area within the grounds where dogs can be exercised off the lead.

Deposits and Cancellations

For Christmas and New Year's Eve, you are required to confirm your booking with a deposit of £100.00 per person (excluding children sharing their parents' bedroom). This deposit will be refundable without question, for any cancellation received by 30th September. We will require your confirmation by the 30th September, with a further non-refundable payment to increase your deposit to 25% of your total accommodation cost. We advise all guests to obtain Holiday/Travel insurance. Policies can be obtained at reasonable rates from a Post Office or insurance broker.

Cottages and Holiday Homes

You can have the space and privacy of a cottage but enjoy the full festive programme at the given rates, or self catering only at our usual rates and we'll add a decorated Christmas tree and welcome gift for you.

Dinner Dress

With the exception of our New Year's Eve Dinner Dance where the dress code is 'black tie', we do not have a formal dress code. We do ask our guests to dress smartly for dinner though and to make it a bit of an occasion, so jackets for gentlemen preferred please (no shorts, t-shirts, trainers please).

No allowance can be made to the accommodation charge for meals not taken.
